A few weeks ago 10 children in Year 6 participated in the Junior Maths Challenge (JMC). The JMC is run by the UK Mathematics Trust and encourages mathematical reasoning, precision of thought, and fluency in using basic mathematical techniques to solve interesting problems. The problems on the JMC are designed to make students think. The challenge involved answering 25 multiple choice questions in one hour under normal exam conditions. In recent years over 250,000 pupils have taken part from around 3,700 schools. Certificates are awarded to the highest scoring 40% of candidates. I am delighted to announce Steven and Lily were awarded with a Silver certificate and Rowan was awarded a Bronze certificate. Congratulations-we are very proud of your achievements

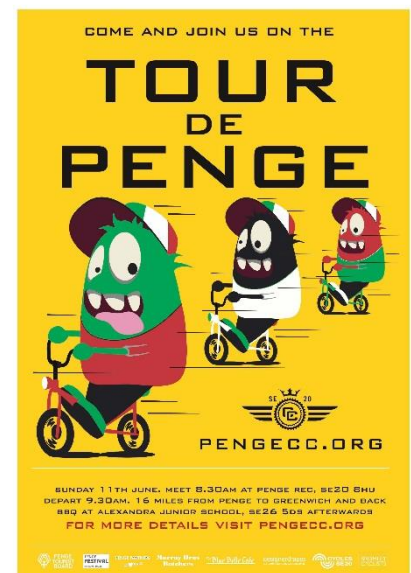
COMMUNITY EVENTS
