## HEALTH AND SAFETY

### Medication

As a school we receive very strict guidance on the medication we can administer during school time. If an antibiotic is prescribed for 3 times a day, medical guidance states that this should be managed by parents or carers. Doses can be given before school, at the end of the school day and the final one before bed time. We can only administer antibiotics prescribed for **4 times a day**.
