This morning we were joined by Sue Smit from Morrell Handwriting. Sue is a handwriting expert and she hosted a very well attended parent session on supporting children at home with their writing.

During Sue's workshop she shared a range of warm ups and discussed the importance of a good sitting position. Parents were shown a range of exercises and activities to build up muscle control to help to improve letter formation and writing stamina. The feedback from parents was really positive and will be ordering a range of resources for school as well as some for parents to buy and use at home. We will write in due course with information on how to order.

Sue then spent the rest of the day working with children, class teachers and TAs, training us on how to make improvements to help children write neatly, quickly and comfortably. Sue thoroughly enjoyed her day and the staff were incredibly positive about the guidance they received so we will be booking another date later in the year!
