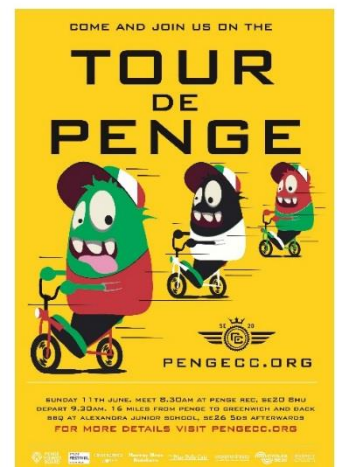
COMMUNITY EVENTS

Penge cycle club invites Worsley Bridge families to join The 2017 Tour de Penge – a free community bike ride from Penge to Greenwich and back on Sunday 11th June. Sign on in Penge Recreation Ground SE20 8HU from 08:30am with the ride starting at 9:30am.

The Tour de Penge takes up to 300 cyclists of all ages and abilities on a guided, safe and mostly off-road route from Penge to the iconic Cutty Sark in Greenwich and back, a round trip of 16 flat miles.

You don't have to be a member of Penge Cycle Club to join in.
