If parents in KS2 haven't activated accounts yet please contact Mrs Wood in the office because she can extend the activation time limit.

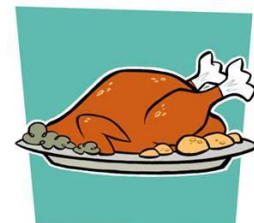
We have included an option for you to contribute to our school fund. If families can donate £1 per child per term it helps us to pay for treats and extras for
