





When should I report to CEOP...?

If you are being asked to **do something** that makes you feel uncomfortable **Stop**

If someone is being **insistent on meeting up** **Stop**

Maybe **inappropriate chat messages** you are receiving **Stop**

Someone acted **aggressively or threatened you** online, or another child you know **Stop**

What you say online should pass through three gates

Ask yourself is it **TRUE?**

Ask yourself is it **NECESSARY?**

Ask yourself is it **KIND?**

Options if you are being bullied online...

Tell the Head Teacher
 Under new laws, the head teacher of a school now has the power to "police cyber-bullying carried out by pupils - even at home"

Tell CEOP
 If you think it is worthy of a CEOP report, then the police will listen to your problems and investigate accordingly

What else do CEOP say...?

WE ARE HERE TO HELP!
 "We are police officers. We take this very seriously".

CHECK YOUR USERNAME!
 "Don't tell people who you are - use a fun nickname instead".

TRUST YOUR TUMMY!
 "If anything makes your stomach feel funny, tell an adult you trust, or CEOP....".

Advice for young people...

Don't give personal information to strangers

People aren't always who they say they are, even on games

Don't use your full name for your email / screen name

Only be friends with people online that you have actually met

TELL SOMEONE YOU TRUST IF SOMETHING GOES WRONG - PARENT, TEACHER, CHILDLINE OR CEOP
