Pick up/Drop Off

Holidays

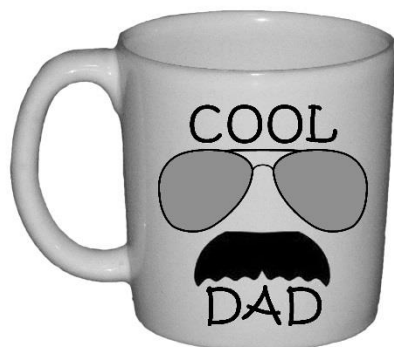
