Over the past few weeks I have been working with teachers and support staff to review the behaviour policy at Worsley Bridge to ensure that it meets the needs of our growing school.

When Ofsted visited they said:

"Behaviour is good. Pupils enjoy school and their families are confident that they are looked after well and feel safe."

I would certainly agree. The children at Worsley Bridge have continued to impress us all with their positive attitudes and good behaviour and the work we have undertaken on the policy is designed to recognise and reward the children for the things they are doing well.

On Monday 30th November we will be introducing **The Worsley Way**:

At Worsley Bridge Primary School we:

- believe in ourselves and are aspirational;
- are honest and use kind words to show we care for and respect each other;
- show gratitude by appreciating our school and the community around us;
- are resilient because we try our hardest, even if we are faced with a challenge;
- are curious and enthusiastic learners who can work collaboratively and independently.

In addition, all classrooms will receive their '**Good to be Green, Great to be Gold**' behaviour chart, which will act as a visual reminder to show the children how well they are doing throughout the day. Every child's name will be on their class chart and behind it will sit several coloured cards. At the start of the school the card will be green, but if your child demonstrates that they are working hard they will be asked to change their colour to silver. If the hard work and great behaviour continues the card will change to gold. Any child who finishes the day on gold will 'bank' their card. The school council will meet this week to decide how we reward our 'golden' children.

There will also be a series of other coloured cards. In the unlikely event that a child chooses to behave in a negative way there will be consequences and these are explained fully in the behaviour policy, which you can find on our brand new website.

This note is a brief summary of the key changes we will be implementing, but for those parents who would like to learn more we will be hosting a workshop on **Monday 7th December at 9am** in the KS1 hall. We look forward to seeing you.
