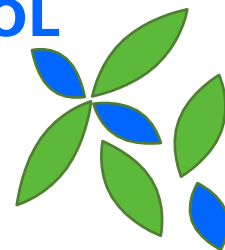

Year 1 Curriculum Letter Autumn 2 2016

Welcome back after half term. We hope you had a great week. We have a busy half term ahead packed with lots of great learning

English

This half term we are basing our English on the books 'Michael Recycle' by Ellie Bethel and 'The Jolly Postman' by Janet and Allan Ahlberg.

Learning will include:

Story writing, letter writing, role play to explore characters, sentence writing looking closely at how capital letters and full stops are used and broadening the children's vocabulary.

We are continuing with our phonics learning this half term. We are looking at phase 3 phonics and the children have daily phonics lessons.

Please support your child's reading by listening to them read for at least **10 minutes** a day.

Mathematics

This half term we will be exploring addition, subtraction, division, multiplication, fractions and time. We will be teaching the children many different methods to help them solve mathematical problems, please support them practise these methods at home.

Science

We will be exploring seasonal changes and keeping healthy.

History, Geography, Art and DT

Our topic is 'The Gun Powder Plot' in history, we will be exploring the significance of this event in British history. In Geography we are looking at recycling and the effects not recycling has on our planet. In Art we will continue to develop the children's skills. We are going to focus on art work by Kandinsky.

MFL

This year we will be learning Spanish. We will explore greetings, family members, colours, and animals.

RE

We will be looking at Hinduism this half term, the children will learn about life as a Hindu, where they worship, what they believe and important stories for Hindus.

PE

PE lessons will be once a week on a Wednesday and children need to have a PE kit in school **at all times**.

Reminders.

Children must bring their book bags in to school **every day**. This is a vital communication tool for us. Please send your child with a water bottle that they can keep in school. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit in school every week and that **1W** have their forest school clothes in school.

Helping your child to learn
