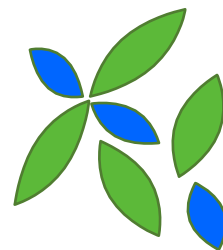

Year 5 Curriculum Letter Spring 1 2017

English

In English lessons the children will be reading *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty. This will be the basis for persuasive writing, play scripts and writing in role of a character.

In reading the children will continue to develop their inference and retrieval skills.

Mathematics

The children will be building up their knowledge of place value, developing their written methods for addition and subtraction and working with money and decimals.

Science

In science the children will be exploring properties of materials and also learning about animals and humans, including life cycles.

Computing

Children will be creating multimedia presentations about Victorian life.

History

In history the children will be learning about what life was like for children living in Victorian Britain.

Geography

In geography we will be learning about how the British Empire spread around the world.

Art and DT

In art the children will be exploring the work of William Morris, as well as creating Victorian decoupage artwork. In DT we will be looking at the work of Brunel and designing and making model bridges.

Music

The children will be listening to and giving opinions on music from the Victorian era.

MFL

Children will continue to extend their vocabulary.

RE

In RE the children will be learning about the beliefs of Sikhism.

PE

We will be developing team work in team games with the Football Coaching Academy.

PSHE

We will be focusing on British values.
