



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In English we are reading Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram. We will be exploring the different characters in the book and their role on the moon. We will be exploring fiction and non-fiction writing through letters, postcards, descriptive writing and story writing. The children will be applying their grammar knowledge to the writing. The reading focus is designed to increase fluency and develop comprehension skills further.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths this term we will looking at Place Value, the children will be working with numbers up to and over 100. They will be writing numbers, ordering numbers and looking at the relationships between numbers. Later in the term we will be looking at addition and subtraction and written methods for solving problems. We will then move onto multiplication and division. Throughout our topics we will focus on problem solving and answering mathematical word problems.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Art / Design and Technology</p> <p>We will be exploring different media to create moon pictures. We will also be generating our own 3D models of the planets in our solar system. In these topics the children will be exploring the role of colour, texture and material and how these can impact on the art we produce. Using the design process and exploring materials, the children will design a moving vehicles (moon buggies).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>The children will be encouraged to explore the properties of materials and think about everyday materials in the world around them. The children will develop their independent thinking by asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways. They will also observe and explain their findings using scientific language.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>During the term the children will be exploring the different British Values and how these apply in their own lives. They will also apply some of these values to their study of different Christian festivals, with an emphasis on Christmas.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>The children will be exploring the history of space travel and who the first people to visit Space were. We will explore in detail what it is like to be an astronaut and live in space for long periods of time. The children will research, using a variety of sources, different astronauts and compare the differences between two famous Astronauts. The children will think about how to present their findings using a range of historical vocabulary.</p>	 <p>WORSLEY BRIDGE PRIMARY SCHOOL</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>In geography the children will be learning about our planet, Earth. They will use atlases and maps to explore the different continents and oceans of the world and the different climate conditions. They will then use their observational skills to explore other planets and make links and comparisons between Earth and other planets.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>In year 2 we will be having Music sessions on a Wednesday morning with Ms. Raben. These sessions will be themed around space. The children will be introduced to a new online resource called Purple Mash. On this programme the children will be able to develop their programming skills and general computing skills.</p>
