

English

We will be studying a new class book "Treason" by Berlie Doherty – a rich and exciting historical novel of the Tudor period reading about adventure, friendship, treason and betrayal.

We will use this book to help the children write in a variety of styles including historical stories, diary entries, informal letters and plays etc.

We will also learn about Shakespeare – one of the world's greatest writers - and study and perform parts of his plays.

Maths

Students will be re-inforcing and revisiting all topics learnt to date in preparation for Year 7 – this will include revising the 4 basic operations (+ - ÷ x)

The will also be completing maths investigations and solving problems using patterns and possibilities.

Computing

Children will be researching and creating their own presentation on their favourite Tudor topic.

Science

Children will be investigating, gathering evidence and reporting changes in various science investigations.

Geography

Children will learn about Tudor exploration including the reasons and events involved, comparing with exploration today and understand how the knowledge of the world changed during Tudor reign.

They will explore and compare a world map from Tudor times to a modern world map.

The Tudors



History
