

English

We will be reading The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry. The children will be taking part in debates and roleplay this will support them with writing letters, stories, diary entries, and newspaper reports about issues they have explored through the book. In grammar we will be looking at plurals, prefixes, adjectives and similes and continue to learn high frequency words. In daily phonics sessions we will continue learning the phase 5 sounds, tricky words and alternative sounds.

Maths

We are starting off our summer term learning about data and statistics. The children are learning how to collect and present data in pictograms and bar graphs. We are then moving on to looking understanding the place value of numbers 50-100, along with revisiting money. We will be ending the year looking at length, height, perimeter and area through a range of practical activities.

Art / Design and Technology

. The children will also have the opportunity to make tribal inspired jewellery and weave their own bowls, make a tribal village, tribal art and make musical instruments. We are turning the class into a rainforest, they will making vines, snakes, parrots and sloths. We will then be looking at tribal art, mask and clothing and trying to create our own. We will explore the layers of the rainforest and create a display around this.

Science

The children will be looking at habitats within the rainforest. This will include looking at food chains, the different species of animals and food that grows in the rainforest. In addition to this the children will also look at identifying different types of plants and materials.

Computing

We will continue our work on coding through map activities guiding the animals to different places and the children are completing a range of programs on Purple mash to help design and create our tribal village.

History

We will explore a Tribe throughout time that live in the amazon rainforest. We will be looking at how the tribe live, what their lives were like and how that has changed over time and the reasons why it has changed.

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Geography

We will begin by locating the rainforests on a map of the world and looking at the equator and tropical region. The children will explore the weather in the rainforest and create their own weather reports, we will look at the layers of the rainforest and what lives in each layer and rivers in the rainforest. We will introduce the children to famous explorers such as David Attenborough and Steve Backshall watch some of the footage he has captured in the Rainforest.

Music

We are creating rainforest sounds by using a range of instruments and exploring and creating tribal music. We will be exploring different volumes, rhythms and tempos.
