### Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to start today's letter by saying a huge **THANKYOU** and well done to 1B for their fabulous Rainforest themed assembly. It had everything a perfect assembly should have: clear voices, interesting facts and information, great costumes and wonderful singing!

It has been a busy day in school today as our classes have been spending the day learning about their chosen 'World Cup' country. Each room has been a sea of colour as the children have dressed in their flag colours and the work being produced looks wonderful. I am really looking forward to seeing it appear on the displays throughout school! As a school we constantly review the safety procedures and protocols we have in place. Any visitor attending school must sign in and display a sticker to show they have permission to be in the building. All our exits are controlled by a fob and gates are on timers and manned at key times throughout the day.



Every term we undertake a fire drill. This allows us to time how long an evacuation takes and to look at any areas that may need to be improved. The children have been excellent during these practices including when the alarm went off due to the dust created by the workmen decorating a classroom earlier this year!

As a school it is also good practice to undertake an evacuation off site. In the unlikely event of a real fire we would move the children to St Paul's Church. We have arranged with the church to undertake a practice later this term.

Another procedure for us to trial with the children will be a school lock down. This is where we would close the school and secure the children and staff within the building. A trigger for a lock down might include things like an intruder, loose dog or swarm of bees. So that we don't confuse the children with a fire drill, key staff will sound a whistle throughout school to signal that all pupils must return to classrooms, pull down blinds and sit quietly until the all clear is given.

Again we plan to undertake a lockdown in the next few weeks and we want you to be aware so that you can reassure the children that these processes are designed to keep them safe in the event of an emergency. Please be reassured that this is good practice and intended to train the children and staff so they are confident in any emergency situation and that there is nothing to be worried about.

This afternoon we welcomed our new reception children into school. It was wonderful to see so many familiar faces as well as having the opportunity to welcome new families. The new children made a confident start to life at Worsley Bridge and thoroughly enjoyed the session. At this meeting we announced that Mr Bennett will be taking over the role of Deputy Headteacher as sadly we will be saying goodbye to Mrs Palmer in July as she will be returning home to Australia in the summer and we couldn't convince her to commute!



