



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>This half term we are reading 'Grace and Family' and will be participating in role play, speaking and listening and writing about the story. The children are learning to talk to an adult or peer about what they are going to write and to say their sentence before they write it. Children are going to be describing events and experiences using appropriate topical vocabulary and write a sequence of connected events, in an appropriate order. Children are going to be focusing on writing full sentences and questions using capital letters, spaces between words, full stops, adjectives and connectives.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>During the first few weeks children will be consolidating the EYFS Early Learning Goals; counting groups of objects to 20; understanding how numbers are constructed from 11 – 20; ordering numbers from 0-20 and working on finding out one more and one less. The children will then move on to place value; reading and writing numbers to 30; writing numbers to 20 in words and comparing and ordering numbers. In addition and subtraction, children will learn their doubles of numbers up to 10, their number bonds to 10 and will be learning how to add repeated numbers, eg 4 + 4 + 4 as well as solving addition and subtraction problems</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Children will find out more about the marvelous machines that are their bodies! They will learn the names and functions of different parts of their bodies before looking at each of the five senses.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Children will be learning about online safety. We will be using a computing scheme of work called Purple Mash. Children will learn how to log in and explore the programme.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Children will be comparing their current life and interests with their babyhood (e.g. clothes, toys, food, size, abilities), recalling a significant memory from their past. They will extend their vocabulary and begin to describe similarities and differences between historical artefacts and pictures.</p>	<p style="color: green;"><u>Year 1 - Me and My World</u></p>  <p style="color: green;">Children will be learning about themselves as well as the world around them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Children will be learning to use correct terms for simple geographical features in the local environment. We will be thinking about where our families are from and locating the countries on a map.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art, design and technology</p> <p>Children will be talking about events that have happened in their lives and will be creating drawings based on their experiences, using oil pastels, collage and paints. They will describe the sensory properties of a range of different materials and decide which ones to use when they create their own pieces of art work.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE and PSHE</p> <p>We will be learning about the Christian creation story and about how Christians think that the world should be treated. In PSHE, the children will take part in group play and conversations related to being kind. We will be thinking about different acts of kindness we can show to each other and how to make kindness at the heart of all of our actions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Enrichment</p> <p>This half term children are taking part in tennis lessons by coaches from Langley Park tennis club. We are also engaging in weekly sessions at 'Forest School'. During Modern Foreign Language lessons the children will be introduced to the German language. In Music, children are learning to sing with a sense of shape and melody.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Homework</p> <p>Reading- Books will be changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday if the previous book has been read at home. Children will be sent Maths and English or Phonics homework each Friday, to be returned by the following Wednesday.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Key Dates</p> <p>This half term the children are transitioning into Year 1 and adapting to the variety of subjects and activities.
