




<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>In English the children will be developing a love of reading and writing through the book <i>Traction Man is Here</i> by Mini Grey. We will be exploring the different characters in the books and the exciting adventures they go on. We will be looking at fiction writing through letters, postcards, descriptive writing and story writing. The children will be applying their grammar knowledge to the writing. Our reading focus is designed to increase fluency and develop comprehension skills further.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In Maths this term we will looking at Place Value, the children will be working with numbers up to and over 100. They will be writing numbers, ordering numbers and looking at the relationships between them. Later in the term we will be looking at addition and subtraction and formal written methods. We will then move onto multiplication and division. Throughout all of our maths learning, we will focus on problem solving and answering mathematical word problems.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science – Everyday Materials</b></p> <p>Children in Year 2 will learn to identify, classify and describe the everyday materials around them. Children will also be learning to code simple programs, using basic computing vocabulary and functions.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>Children will be taught about real life heroes in the past who helped to change the world, such as Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale, Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake. Through this they will compare aspects of life in different periods.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Children will create a simple map using symbols and keys to plans the route for a local visit. They write a set of instructions to describe the route using compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art, design and technology</b></p> <p>The children will have the opportunity to understand how pop up cards work and they will design and experiment with their own pop up mechanisms and moving pictures. They will also design and make superhero capes and medals linked to our English book of Traction Man.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE &amp; PSHE</b></p> <p>Islam – We will be exploring how the mosque provides a sense of belonging to Muslims. We will also be learning about how Muslims pray at home. In PSHE we will be using 'Mind to be Kind' to develop children's self-esteem, relationships and respect towards others as well as focusing on and emphasising our British Values.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Enrichment</b></p> <p>Music - In year 2 we will be having Music sessions on a Wednesday morning with Ms. Raben. These sessions will be themed around heroes. Children will have the opportunity to play a range of instruments and learn and sing a variety of new song.</p>
