



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>During the term, the children will be reading a selection of texts to support our topic of Prehistoric Britain for example <i>Stone Age Boy</i> and <i>Ug</i>. The children will have the opportunity to write in different genres such as information leaflets, diary entries, plays and narrative writing. The grammar, punctuation and spelling will be focusing on the use of paragraphs and the spelling of common prefixes and suffixes. The reading focus will be on increasing fluency when reading longer texts and developing inference skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths we will be focussing on a range of different units such as: place value, addition and subtraction; along with multiplication and division. We will continue to follow our existing school scheme 'Effective Maths' as the children are familiar with this and is something they enjoy learning from on a daily basis. The children will build on the skills they acquired in Year 2, with timetables becoming a key area they will be focussing on to help with their mathematical fluency.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Rocks and Soils- We will learn about the different types of rocks and their properties, how fossils are made and even create our own volcanoes! Keeping Healthy- We will also study the human skeleton and learn about balanced diets, the different food groups and the importance of exercise.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Computing this term will focus on coding and will give the children the opportunity to design and write a program that accomplishes a specific goal using the iPads. In addition to this the children will use repetition commands, introduce 'if' statements and begin to 'debug' simple programs. We will use the scheme 'Purple Mash'.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We will be studying the Stone Age and asking questions and recording findings in a variety of different ways. We will look at the hunter/gatherer way of life, the tools used and the animals that lived during the Ice Age. We will then explore the developments of mining and farming and how life changed during the Bronze and Iron Ages.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Hunters, Farmers and Prehistoric Beasts</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>We will look at the main physical features of Britain and learn the county names by plotting prehistoric sites on our maps. We will look at land use over time and the effects of mining and farming on our landscape. We will explore what is needed when choosing to create a settlement and learn the compass directions.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art, design and technology</p> <p>We will make our own paints using the method the Stone Age people may have used. We will look at cave paintings and produce our own in a similar style. We will also study how dwellings changed through the prehistoric period. We will have a go at den building and create models of the different types of houses.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE and PSHE</p> <p>RE this term we are learning to understand the reasons why Sikhs may choose to join the Khalsa. This will include lessons on belonging to clubs, making traditional Karah Prashad, learning about the 5 Ks which are important to Sikhs and also about what happens at an Amrit ceremony.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Enrichment</p> <p>The Language we are learning this half term is Spanish, where we will be focussing on introducing ourselves. We will be listening to and analysing classical music. Forest school will take place on a Wednesday morning. In PE the children will be focussing on multi skills and Gymnastics on a Wednesday afternoon.</p>
