



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>We are covering a range of books in English: Dear Dinosaur, Michael Recycle and Jolly postman. Each book will engage the children in different writing genres. This will include letter writing, postcards, story writing, debates, non-chronological reports and newspaper reports. They will have the opportunity to apply their phonic skills as well as the basic grammar that they are beginning to learn such as sentence structure and adjectives.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>This term we will be focussing on a variety of skills such as: time (On the hour and half past), fractions, looking at $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of objects/amounts and problem solving (word problems). These skills will be covered again during the year, however the Autumn term 2 is a great chance to introduce the children to the curriculum and begin to develop their deeper thinking. Children will continue to master their key facts such as number bonds to 10 and 20 as well as the rapid recall of doubles of numbers up to 10</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>The children will focus on learning about seasons, looking at the changes that happen throughout the year. They will continue learning about their senses. The children will be encouraged to ask questions and to use their observations to explain their thinking and start to think in scientific ways..</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>We will continue using a computing scheme of work called Purple Mash. We will be using a range of programs to look at the initial skills needed when programming and coding. The children will be using these in relation to our topic, English and Maths learning.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We will look at Dinosaurs throughout time, fossils and extinction. As part of Black History Month children will learn about Rosa Parks and her influence on law changing. Children will learn the significance of Remembrance Day and they will create poppies as part of the school project.</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Year 1 - Autumn 2</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Roarsome Dinosaurs</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>We are focussing on where dinosaurs lived and why they may have lived there. We are then moving onto Recycling and 10 Things I can do to help my world. The children will be developing basic vocabulary and location skills.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art, design and technology</p> <p>This term we will be making dinosaurs using a range of different materials and tools to make Dinosaur finger paintings, dinosaurs and dinosaur eggs. The children will also design and make a dinosaur sculpture, design and make their own dinosaurs and create fossils.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE and PSHE</p> <p>This term we will be focusing on Hinduism and the festival of light and Christianity and the Christmas story. Through this the children will be gaining further understanding of the wider community and links with our British Values.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Enrichment & P.E.</p> <p>This half term children are taking part in gymnastics lessons every Wednesday. Please note there is no Forest School this half term. During Modern Foreign Language lessons the children will continue to learn German. In Music, children will continue to learn to sing and will also start learning our songs for the Christmas production.</p>
