



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In English the children will be developing a love of reading and writing through the book <i>Man on the Moon</i> by Simon Bartram. We will be exploring the main character in the book and the exciting job he has. We will be writing non-fiction texts such as fact files, brochures, advertisements and newspaper reports. Closer to the winter break we will be studying <i>The Snowman</i>, a picture book with no words and the children will be attending the theatre to enhance their understanding.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths this term we will looking at multiplication and division. The children will be learning their 2, 5, and 10 times table and should be able to recall these when questions, as well as use these to solve simple problems. In division children will use the sharing and grouping methods to solve problems, as well as using their knowledge of the times tables. They will be taught that multiplication and division are in the inverse of each other. We will be using bar models to help visualise problems and solve them.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science – Everyday Materials</p> <p>Children in Year 2 will learn to identify, classify and describe the everyday materials around them. They will explore the properties of materials, such as wood, plastic, metal, glass and fabric, through a variety of fun activities.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Children will continue to learn to code simple programs, using basic computing vocabulary and functions. They will learn how to access and use the basic functions of computers and tablets.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Children will be taught about real life heroes in the past who helped to change the world, such as Mary Seacole, Florence Nightingale, Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake. Through this they will compare aspects of life in different periods.</p>	<p>Year 2 Autumn 2</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Children will create a simple map using symbols and keys to plans the route for a local visit. They write a set of instructions to describe the route using compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art, design and technology</p> <p>The children will have the opportunity to understand how pop up cards work and they will design and experiment with their own pop up mechanisms. They will also design and make superhero capes and medals for our special Heroes Award Ceremony.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE & PSHE</p> <p>Christianity –We will be discussing the Christian views on what Jesus taught us, and exploring Christmas as a gift from God.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be continuing with ‘Mind to be Kind’ to develop children’s self-esteem, relationships and respect towards others as well as focusing on and emphasising our British Values.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Enrichment & PE</p> <p>On Tuesday mornings children will enjoy Forest School, they will need to come in wearing their forest school clothes, no need to bring uniform or school bags on this day. As P.E. will now be on Tuesday afternoons and children will come home wearing P.E kits.</p> <p>We will be continuing our Music sessions on a Wednesday morning with Ms. Raben.</p>
