


<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>This term we will be Children will continue to explore the English language through rich and meaningful texts from the Power of Reading scheme. This term will cover Shakespeare's <i>Antony and Cleopatra</i> and <i>Varjak Paw</i> by SF Said. Children will be using informative language to develop different pieces of writing such as newspaper articles and sets of instructions. We will also continue to develop their creative writing by using descriptive language and varying sentence structure to write recounts. The children should be securing the habit of using basic punctuation (capital letters and full stops) so that before moving on to develop a more sophisticated use of punctuation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Children will continue to follow the Effective Maths scheme which encourages collaboration and forming a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts. This term we are moving on to multiplication and division. Children will be understanding the use of division and how it relates to multiplication. Children will be focusing on the 4, 8, 7 and 9 times tables as well as revisiting the 2, 5, 10, 4 and 8 times tables. By the end of the year, children need to know all of their times tables up to 12 x 12. We will be practising how to interpret and solve problems with multiplication and division. They will also be learning about fractions and will recognise common fractions of shapes and amounts.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Science will be covered both with the school's science specialist and in class. The topics will include plants, habitats and food chains and the human body, healthy eating and teeth. Children will investigate how to stay healthy and what makes for a healthy, balanced diet</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Year 4 will be continuing to learn the important skill of coding. They will use the coding programme 'Purple Mash' to facilitate them in both creating and debugging code. They are learning to become more independent reading and interpreting instructions.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We are continuing our learning journey of Ancient Egypt this term, looking further into the lives of Ancient Egyptians, God's and Pharaoh's.
