



<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>In English we are reading The Lonely Beast by Chris Judge. We will be exploring the different character in the book and the exciting adventure that he goes on. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction writing through letters, news reports, postcards, descriptive writing and story writing. The children will be applying their year 2 grammar and punctuation knowledge to their writing. Our reading focus is designed to increase fluency and develop comprehension skills further.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In Maths this term we will looking at place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Later in the term we will move onto fractions, finding fractions of amounts and solving fraction word problems. We will also be looking at statistics where the children will be introduced to data analysis and creating graphs from data. We will continue to develop the children's problem solving skills and explore mathematical vocabulary to support them with this.</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art / Design and Technology</b></p> <p>We are very excited to say the children will be creating their own replica Stuart London house using a variety of materials. Then under the watchful eye of Beckenham Fire Brigade we will set light to it to re-enact The Great Fire of London and have our own Great Fire of Worsley Bridge. The children will then evaluate the resources used for their replica street.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>This half term we will be continuing to look at the properties of materials and then move on to look at animals including humans and how they grow. The children will develop their independent thinking by asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways. They will also observe and explain their findings using scientific language.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>During the term the children will be exploring Judaism specifically looking at Passover. Then we will be learning about Christianity and the meaning of Easter and why it is important to Christians.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>The children will be exploring The Plague and The Great Fire of London this term. The children will look at when these events happened in history. We will look at the differences between life then and life now in London, what caused the fire and how and why it spread so easily. They will be using street maps of London to locate the journey of the Great Fire of London and where it began. The children will look at how London has developed since 1666 and at how weather conditions and the types of buildings affected the fire.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Homework</b></p> <p>Reading books will be changed every Monday, Wednesday and Friday.</p> <p><b>Spelling will be given out and are due back on every Friday</b>, and a test will take place in school on this day.</p> <p>Maths and English homework will be given each Friday and due back the following Tuesday. Occasionally this will also include Topic homework.
