



<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>During this half term the children, will be reading the book 'Krindlekrax' which is a very engaging, humorous novel which explores the concepts of friendship and heroism. The children will have the opportunity to write in different genres such as playscripts, narrative including setting and character descriptions and produce news reports. In Grammar, we will learn more about adverbs, adjectives and consolidate our use of speech marks. The reading focus will be on summarising key information and skimming the text to find answers.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths we will be focusing on: geometry, money, decimals and the second place value module. Within geometry the focus will be on different angles, parallel and perpendicular lines, clockwise/anti clockwise turns and revision of 2D and 3D shapes. When covering money, the children will continue to become fluent recognising the value of coins, by adding and subtracting different amounts. They will also learn to record the £ and p separately. In place value the children will continue to count in 1s, 10s and 100s so they can become fluent in the order and place value of numbers to 1000.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Plants- We will examine how a plant grows and what it needs to keep healthy. The children will learn about the life-cycle of a flowering plant and the names of the different parts of a plant.</p> <p>Light- We will design an experiment to examine how light rays travel through different materials and how shadows are formed. We will investigate how light is affected by a concave and convex lens.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Computing this term will look at teaching the children to type with two hands. This is to enable them to type quickly instead of typing one letter at a time which can be very time consuming. We will also continue to learn about the functions of other keys on the keyboard and also functions such as how to save our work and closing down the computer safely.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>We will be studying the life of Charles Darwin as a local historical figure. We will learn about different aspects of his life including studying his voyage in detail. We will also be using primary and secondary sources from Bromley Museum to develop our research skills in our study of the history of Beckenham.</p>	<p>Year 3 Spring 1 Charles Darwin and our Local Area</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>This half term we will be looking at the topic of navigation, including lines of latitude and longitude while improving our own navigational skills. We will also focus on studying the local area of Beckenham and considering how it has changed. We will complete and analyse surveys on the types of shops, facilities and transport there is within our local area.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art, design and technology</p> <p>We will study the impressionist artists including Georges Seurat and we will recreate the painting technique of 'Pointillism' which he developed. In Design and Technology, we will be designing and creating model flowers from recycled rubbish, thinking about how to join and strengthen the materials.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE and PSHE</p> <p>In RE this term we will be learning to recall key events in the Easter story and looking to understand why Jesus' crucifixion symbolises hope for Christians. More specifically we will be posing the question 'What was good about good Friday?' to the children.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Enrichment & P.E.</p> <p>This term within enrichment we will be focussing on the 'Worsley way' which are our updated set of school rules. PE this term will focus on cross country in preparation for the Y3 Bromley cross country on 7th March at Crystal Palace Park. We will also be doing hockey with the coaches.</p>

Books should be brought in every Thursday.
