



<p>English</p> <p>In English we will be reading 'If I built a house' By Chris Van Dousen where we will be planning and creating our own houses. 'The Gruffalo's Child' by Julia Donaldson and Axel Scieffler, where we will be exploring the characters and their homes in the book. We will also be reading 'See inside Castles' by Katie Daynes where we will be looking at the layout and features of information books. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction writing through descriptive writing and story writing. The children will be applying their phonics knowledge to their writing. Our reading focus is designed to cover the phase 5 and to increase fluency and develop basic comprehension skills further.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths this term we will looking at correct number formation, counting, place value, addition and subtraction. Later in the term we will move onto fractions, finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ as a fraction of shapes. We will also be looking at time where the children will be introduced to reading a clock to the nearest hour and half hour. We will continue to develop the children's shape knowledge and improve their problem-solving skills by exploring mathematical vocabulary and puzzles.</p>	
<p>Art</p> <p>The children will be using different mediums to explore painting and drawing techniques. They will also be creating their own homes and castles out of cardboard and other materials.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science, the children will be learning about seasonal changes. We will look at the differences between each season, the changes that occur and how seasons are different across the world. We will be looking at the beginning of the life cycle of chicks in the first week after half term.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In R.E. we will be looking at Christianity and learning what it means to be a good friend and how Christians use the example that Jesus set to be a good friend to all, with a focus.</p>
<p>History</p> <p>The children will be exploring how homes have changed through history. We will be looking at different features of houses through years and will be creating our own house for the future.</p>	 <p>WORSLEY BRIDGE PRIMARY SCHOOL</p>	
<p>Design Technology</p> <p>We are very excited to say the children will be designing and creating their own houses using junk modelling to be creative and use their imagination.
