

<p>English</p> <p>During the term, the children will be reading a selection of texts to support our topic of prehistoric Britain, including <i>Stone Age Boy</i> and <i>My Side of the Mountain</i>. The children will have the opportunity to write in different genres such as information leaflets, diary entries, playscripts and narrative writing. The grammar, punctuation and spelling will be focusing on the use of paragraphs and the spelling of common prefixes and suffixes. The reading focus will be on increasing fluency when reading longer texts and developing inference skills.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths we will be focusing on a range of different units such as: place value, addition and subtraction, along with multiplication and division. We will continue to follow our existing school scheme 'Effective maths' as the children are familiar with this and is something they enjoy learning from on a daily basis. The children will build on the skills they acquired in year two, with times tables becoming a key area that we will be focusing on to help with the children's mathematical fluency.</p>	
<p>History</p> <p>We will be studying the Stone Age and asking questions and recording findings in a variety of different ways. We will look at the hunter/gatherer way of life, the tools used and the animals that lived during the ice age. We will then explore the developments of mining and farming and how life changed during the Bronze and Iron Ages.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Rocks and soils – We will learn about the different types of rocks and their properties, how fossils are made and about how soil is formed.</p> <p>Keeping healthy – We will also study the human skeleton, learn about a balanced diet, the different food groups and the importance of exercise</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>We will look at the main physical features of Britain and learn the county names by putting prehistoric sites on our maps. We will look at land use over time and the effects of mining and farming on our landscape. We will explore what is needed when choosing to create a settlement and learn the compass directions.</p>
<p>Art and Design Technology</p> <p>We will make our own paints using the method Stone Age people may have used. We will look at paintings and produce our own in a similar style. We will also study how dwellings changed through the pre-start period. <p>PSHE</p> <p>More than ever it is important that we as a school focus on the children's wellbeing. In the first term we will look at topics such as healthy lifestyles, keeping safe, feelings and emotions and also caring for the environment.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE this term we are learning to understand the reasons why Sikhs may choose to join the Khalsa. This will include lessons on belonging to clubs, making traditional Karah Prashad, learning about the five Ks which are important to Sikhs and also about what happens at an Amrit ceremony.</p>	<p>MFL</p> <p>Over the course of the year the children will be learning Spanish. In the Autumn term we will begin with general vocabulary such as numbers, colours and greetings. The children will build on this throughout the year leading up to sentence constructing both verbally and written.</p>
<p>Home Learning</p> <p>Children will be given weekly spellings and are also encouraged to practise their times tables in preparation for the 'screening' test in Year 4.</p> <p>In addition, we will also be using Google classroom so that we are able to provide work for those children in isolation and also to manage home learning safely.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In Music the children will be taught to listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory. They will also learn to use and understand staff and other musical notations.</p>	<p>PE/Forest School</p> <p>PE lessons on Thursdays will be focussing on stamina/ endurance to prepare the children for cross country. We will also be doing 'Key steps' gymnastics weekly.</p> <p>In forest school we will be working collaboratively to build shelters.</p>
