


<p>English In English we are looking at traditional stories. We will be writing story narratives and looking at the different components that make a good story. We will be focusing on developing their vocabulary and their use of four sentences types. Statement, commands, questions and exclamation. We will be looking at the related punctuation including apostrophes and commas. Later in the term, we will be looking at poetry. The children will be learning about acrostic and shape poems.</p>	<p>Maths In Maths this term we will looking at place value, calculation, length, money and decimals. We will be looking at a variety of different methods and solving a range of mathematical problems within the different areas.</p>		
<p>History For history, we will be looking at a range of historical elements from different cultures around the world. This will include exploring traditional music, clothing, architecture and much more. We will explore how cultures are shaped by these components and how it influences the way people live around the world.</p>	<p>Science We will continue to learn about what habitats are, including micro-habitats, and the animals within. We will explore the features of a range of habitats and even have a go at making our own. We will also be looking at food chains, learning how to read and represent them.</p>	<p>Geography In Geography, we will be learning about the 7 continents and focusing on several countries within each one. We will explore the climates and human and physical features of the different locations. We will use this information to identify the similarities and differences between the different countries we study.</p>	
<p>Art and Design Technology The children will work with a range of resources and materials to recreate some traditional pieces of art from around the world. In DT, children will learn to design, make, evaluate and reflect on products, such as a replica of a piece of architecture they have chosen and a traditional piece of clothing from a different culture. They will also be looking at a range of traditional foods from different cultures where we will be investigating the ingredients used based on where the products originally come from.</p>	 <p>Summer 2 2021 Year 2 Around the world in 70 days!</p>		<p>Computing We will be focussing on keyboard skills and simple coding. They will use the computer suite and Ipads to continue on the Purple Mash program where they will create simple programs and use their skills to debug and improve simple pre-written codes. ICT will take place weekly and will also cover the important area of internet safety and how to keep safe on-line.</p>
<p>PSHE (Including RSE) We are continuing our PSHE lessons through SCARF. The summer 2 unit is 'Growing and Changing'. We will look at cooperation and teamwork, feelings, resilience, dealing with change and loss, growing up and how peoples' needs change, labelling body parts (including genitalia), privacy and basic first aid.</p>	<p>RE We are continuing to learn about Judaism and Islam. In Judaism we will be learning about the relationship that Jews have with God and the promises they make to each other. In Islam the children will learn about community, belonging and prayer.</p>	<p>MFL We will be following the schools 'Language of the Week' and introduce simple phrases such as good morning in languages which reflect the diversity of our school community.</p>	
<p>Home Learning Reading, try to read every day for at least 15 minutes so that you can tick off the reading passport and earn your book worm badges. Don't forget to write in the reading record when you have read. Spellings will be given out for the term on a grid, it shows the spellings that you need to learn for the week and the date that they will be tested on. They have been posted on Google Classroom and a paper copy will be sent home with your child. The children will be tested on their spellings on a Friday.</p>	<p>Music Music specialist Ms Rabin will be taking the children's music lessons in small groups of 15. They will be learning to play different percussion instruments in small groups looking at the pitch, rhythm, tempo and beat.</p>	<p>PE/Forest School This term PE will take place on Thursday and Friday afternoons. Thursday's session is with the Mini Munchkins coaches. The children will be taking part in Athletics, doing a range of short activities each week. We will then move on to Tennis lessons with a coach for the last 3 weeks of term where they will practise their ball control, throwing and catching and racket skills.</p>
